Playing the Knox Unconformity Reconnaissance and High Grading Prospects in Holmes County, Ohio

Abstract

The Knox group has produced oil and gas in Holmes County for many decades. Much of the production is attributed to erosional highs or paleotopography developed on the Knox unconformity. In recent years, oil and gas production has been found along the updip truncations of the Beekmantown dolomite, Rose Run sandstone, and Copper Ridge dolomite against the Knox unconformity. In this presentation, I will be playing the Rose Run sandstone truncation edge to find prospective areas of structural/stratigraphic traps against the Knox Unconformity. By using modern exploration software, it is possible to quickly recon and high-grade prospects which previously was a tedious and time consuming process.
